 - b. Has demonstrated advocacy for the Marshall Library
- 3. The Committee will reach a decision by numerical ranking of criteria with total scores determining the recipient.
- 4. Scholarship may not be awarded in a year if the Friends Scholarship Committee determines there are no qualifying or worthy participants.
- 5. Applicants must complete the Scholarship Application and return it to the committee by the date listed above along with a copy of their 1st semester report card or other appropriate documentation that shows aptitude.
- 6. Scholarship Committee will consist of:
 - a. One Friends Board member
 - b. One Library staff member
 - c. One Friends member
- 7. No Committee member will determine an award for a relative.
- 8. Scholarship will consist of \$500
